# Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 117<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 117<sup>th</sup> meeting on 18 February 2013 (Monday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Barry Cheung and attended by 3 executive directors, 14 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from Management. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

### 2013 Basic Pay Review and 2012/13 Performance Based Variable Pay (PBVP)

2. After deliberations, the Board approved (i) the framework, principles and implementation plan for the 2013 pay review; and (ii) the proposed arrangements for the 2012/13 PBVP as set out in the Board paper.

#### **Appointment of Main Operator for the Central Oasis**

3. <u>Members</u> noted the outcomes of the Expression of Interest exercise recently conducted by URA for appointment of Main Operator for the Central Oasis revitalization project. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved a slightly revised operation fee framework being an integral part of the principal tender terms for appointment of the Main Operator.

# Review on Demand-led Redevelopment Scheme

- 4. <u>Members</u> discussed a few possible refinements to conditions precedent to implementation of URA's demand-led redevelopment scheme. After deliberations, the Board agreed that :-
  - (i) the condition that there must be acceptance of the URA's offers by owners of not less than 80% of undivided shares for each lot in the application site should be maintained without change; and
  - (ii) starting from the third round of applications, URA would make it an application requirement that the 67% application threshold should include any owner who owns more than 20% undivided shares of any lot in the application.

## **Progress Reports on Urban Renewal Projects/Initiatives**

5. <u>The Board</u> heard reports from Management on the progress of major urban renewal projects/initiatives and noted the satisfactory progress made.
