Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 152nd Meeting of the URA Board

4. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the proposals as set out in the Board paper for the procurement of consultancy services for a district study to be carried out for Yau Ma Tei and Mong Kok.

Rental Policy for Acquired Properties

5. <u>The Board</u> approved the rental policy as proposed in the Board paper for properties acquired by URA in its redevelopment projects.

Arrangement for Incidental Cost Allowance

6. <u>The Board</u> resolved to refine the arrangement for incidental cost allowance to owners of domestic properties in URA's redevelopment projects, as proposed in the Board paper.
