# Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 171<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 171<sup>st</sup> meeting on 6 February 2020 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Chow Chung-kong and attended by 3 executive directors, 16 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from the Management. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

## Remuneration Review

2. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the recommendations on salary structure and arrangements as proposed in the Board paper, on the basis of a recently conducted remuneration review.

# 2020 Base Pay Review and 2019/20 Performance-based Variable Pay (PBVP)

3. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved (i) the 2020 base pay review recommendations; and (ii) the proposed arrangements for the 2019/20 PBVP, as set out in the Board paper.

#### Appointment of Service Provider in relation to Group Medical Insurance

4. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the appointment of a service provider as proposed in the Board paper for the Group Medical Insurance Scheme of URA and its subsidiaries for the next three fiscal years.

# Assigning Remaining Units in eResidence as Starter Homes (SH) Units

5. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved (i) assigning the remaining units in eResidence as SH units based on the principal terms set out in the Board paper; and (ii) authorizing the Management to work out the detailed implementation arrangements of these units with the Government.

#### Professional Advice and Project Management Support on Transitional Housing

6. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the provision of professional advice and project management support by URA to community groups responsible for implementing relevant transitional housing projects, as proposed in the Board paper.

# Principal Tender Terms for Tonkin Street/Fuk Wing Street Project

7. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the principal tender terms proposed in the Board paper for the joint venture development of Tonkin Street/Fuk Wing Street Project, and authorized the Management to determine the final tender invitation programme.

## Settlement of Stamp Duty Dispute with Inland Revenue Department (IRD)

8. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> agreed that URA should settle its appeal cases on stamp duty with IRD based on principles set out in the Board Paper.

## Progress Reports on Urban Renewal Projects/ Initiatives

9. <u>The Board</u> heard reports from the Management on the progress of other projects/initiatives and noted the satisfactory progress made.
