Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 182nd Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 182nd meeting on 16 December 2021 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. Tender Award for Hung Fook Street / Ngan Hon Street Project

Following the approval, Members noted that the successful tenderer was Port Destiny Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Kerry Properties Limited.

3. After deliberations, the Board approved submission by the Management of the URA's 21st Corporate Plan covering 2022/23 to 2026/27 and 2022/23 Business Plan to the Financial Secretary for approval, pursuant to sections 21 and 22 of the URA Ordinance.
